Support for energy efficiency will save Kansans money and boost local economies.

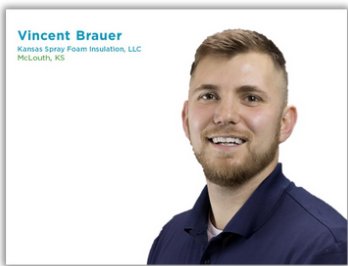
