- You don't know what you don't measure.
- If you measure wrong, you know nothing.





Changes Needed to the TRC et al.

10 Concerns Need Addressing:

- Level of Application
- Time frame
- Proportion of Measure Cost Considered
- Discount rate
- Value other avoided externalities
- Non-Energy Benefits
- Effective Useful Life (EUL) of measures
- Value carbon savings
- Net to gross
- Dual utility jurisdictions



Temporary and Permanent Solutions to the TRC

- Standardized best practices for applying the Total Resource Cost (TRC) test
- Use the Program Administrator Cost Test (PACT) also known as Utility Cost Test
- Modify utility incentive structures to encourage not discourage efficiency.

 Standardization of data collection sets and HPXML will make it easier to collect and transfer data from one system to another;
