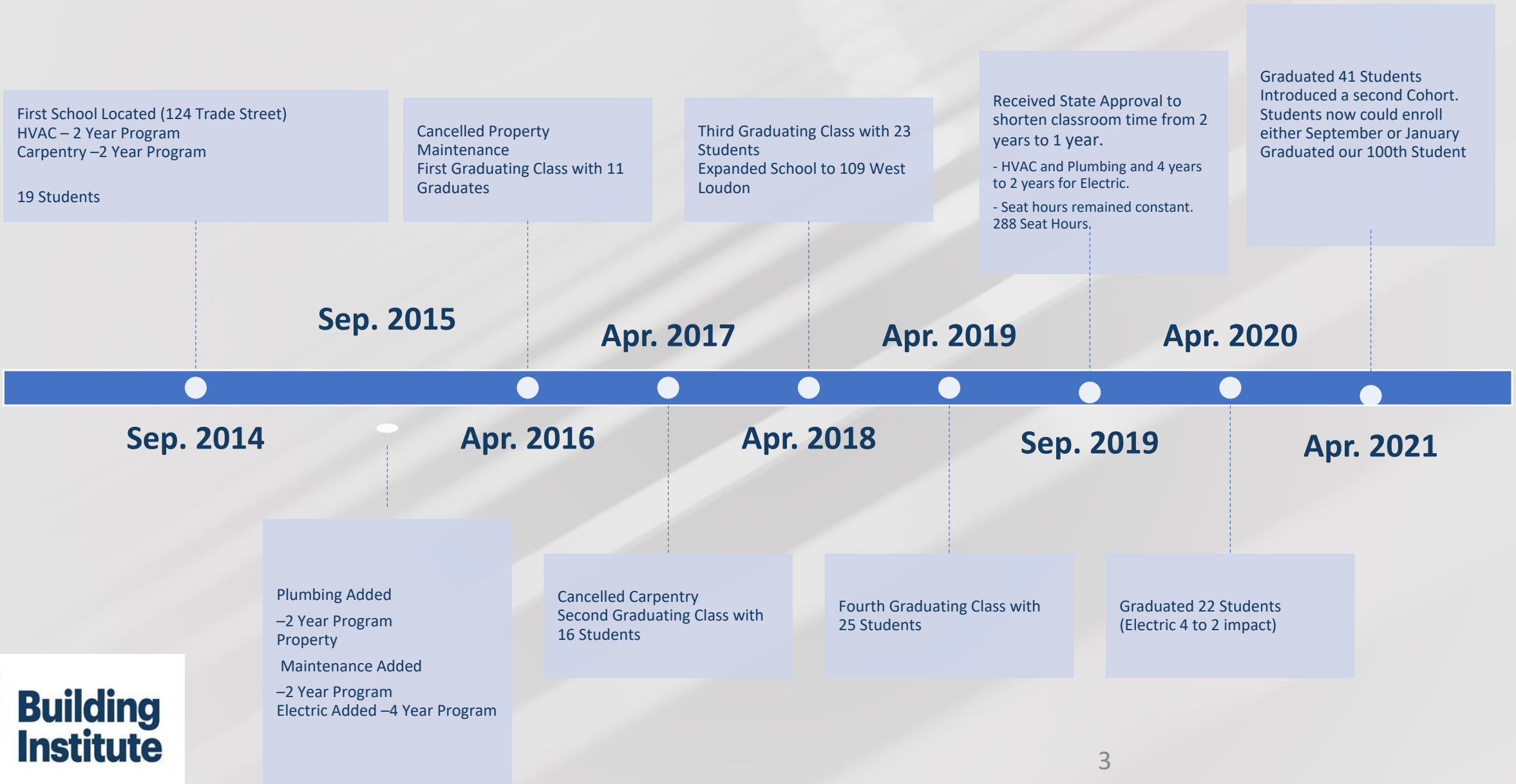

# Building Institute of Central KY

- **The Building Institute of Central Kentucky is owned and operated by the Building Industry Association of Central Kentucky. We are an evening trade school focusing on an accelerated path to licensure for HVAC, Plumbing and Electric.**
- **The School allows students to obtain licensure in half the time of not attending an approved school. We also assist students in employment. 100% of our graduates are employed at graduation. Most are employed by the start of the second semester.**
- **Our Instructors are trade professionals. 3 are graduates of our school. 4 are company owners. Most are Master Licensed.**
- **The School operational hours are 6:00 until 9:00, four nights per week from September thru May. Students work during the day and attend school at night.**
- **Tuition includes textbooks, codebooks, lab expenses, classroom material, school use tools and access to EPA608, OSHA 10, CPR, and First Aid training and/or certification.**

- 100% pass rate on the Electric Journeyman examination.
