The Alabama Energy Infrastructure Training Center and Network (AEITCN) is a program designed to empower homebuilders and contractors to improve energy efficiency in residential buildings.

AEITCN offers two tiers of technical training to equip individuals with skills vital for the energy industry. Participants learn about insulation, air sealing, HVAC, and more to reduce energy usage, utility bills, and create safer homes in Alabama. AEITCN also offers administrative training to develop crucial skills for energy sector support.

Technical Training


Tier 1: Offers comprehensive, occupation specific training that follows a curriculum aligned with the most recent Job-Task Analysis (JTA) for the position. Trainings range from 2-10 days and cover the positions of:

- Crew Leader
- Energy Auditor
- Retrofit Installer Technician
- Quality Control Inspector

Tier 2: Short-term training that addresses gaps in the field. Courses last 1-4 days, and offerings include:

- OSHA Outreach
- Combustion Appliance Zone Testing
- ASHRAE Ventilation
- Basic Refrigeration and HVAC
