Basic Construction Training

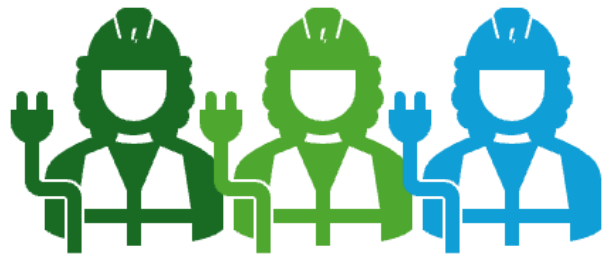
This program covers fundamental skills such as tool handling, safety protocols, and blueprint reading. Participants will also receive training in workplace professionalism, communication, and teamwork to enhance employability.

Graduates receive National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER) Core Skills certification.

Basic Electrical Concepts

This program is designed for individuals in the construction trade with limited existing knowledge on electrical systems. Problem solving and teamwork are also core tenets of the training.

Graduates will develop a technical knowledge of maintenance and repair, load management, and more.
