

Energy Specialist Apprenticeship

Affiliated with Penn State University, the **Pennsylvania Clean Energy Center** offers a wide range of trainings for both residential and commercial buildings, and acts as the state's Weatherization Training Center. The Energy Specialist Apprenticeship is one of many pathways to professional training in residential upgrades.

The **Energy Specialist** registered apprenticeship runs for 65-weeks and includes 2600 hours of on-the-job training. Topics include:

- Customer relations
- Energy modeling
- Building science principles
- Combustion safety testing
- Home energy modeling

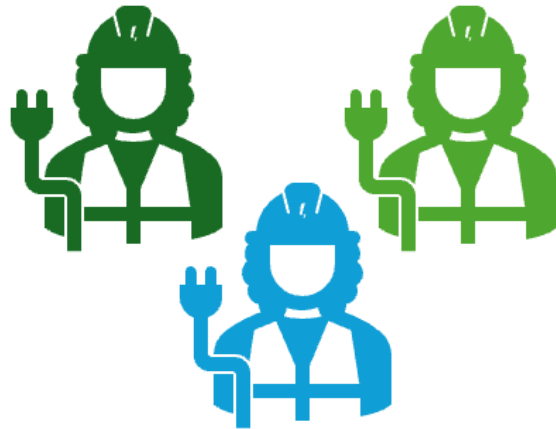
Participants will earn certifications including Building Science Principles, EPA Lead, and OSHA 10. PA CEC utilizes the house-as-a-system approach in residential programs.

CEC also provides training and workforce development for major companies, who can then recruit from the student body.
