

CEJA Workforce Hubs

The Illinois Department of Commerce will develop 13 clean energy workforce hubs under the Climate and Equitable Jobs Act.

Through the Clean Jobs Workforce Network Program (“CEJA Workforce Hubs”), 13 Workforce Hubs across Illinois will offer training, certification preparation, and skill development for entry-level jobs in energy efficiency and other energy-related fields.

Workforce Hubs will offer training in:

- HVAC
- Weatherization
- Energy Efficiency
- And more

The Hubs will ensure that participants are prepared for careers in energy efficiency by leveraging a stakeholder-designed curriculum framework.

The 13 Hubs will be evenly distributed across Illinois and provide training and services to people living near them.

The program will be funded at \$22.9 million per year, subject to appropriation.



The CEJA Workforce Hubs will also offer wrap around services and support in order to help participants overcome barriers to successful completion.

Subject to appropriation, Energy Transition Barrier Reduction Program services and funds will receive \$15 million per year.
