

ReMaine Clean Energy Internship Program

*This internship program is funded by the **Maine Governor's Energy Office** and managed by **Northeast Energy Efficiency Partnerships**, the **JPI Group**, and **E2TECH**.*

Interns must complete 240-320 hours of work during their internship and will earn \$18+/hour.

Areas of work include:

- Energy efficiency: auditors, managers, and building automation specialists.
- Alternative transportation: bike infrastructure designers, transit planners.
- Grid and storage: grid operators, storage technicians.
- Services: policy analysts, regulatory affairs specialists.

Roles are short-term but provide real world experience with working firms throughout Maine.



The ReMaine internship program offers the opportunity for entry-level candidates to gain hands-on experience with Maine employers working across the clean energy sector.

Employers receive wage subsidies of 50% for their interns, helping ensure that more firms can support interns. Interns are able to seek support for childcare and transportation costs, among other supports. Interns also receive mentorship from their employer.
